

NOTES ABOUT OUR LIST...

1. We have broken our list into varietals as well as geographic regions. This means that you may find a wine listed under both the "Syrah" and "Italy" headings. Our list is heavy on French and West Coast wines, so we have not created separate categories for these.
2. We offer many half-size bottles [375 ml]. This allows smaller groups to enjoy a larger variety of wine with their meal. It also means that you can try some higher-end wines without the expense of a full bottle.
3. We will frequently offer additional wines by the glass. If there is a particular wine that you are interested in trying, but not purchasing the entire bottle, let your waiter know so that we can add that wine to the rotation.
4. New York State law now allows you to take home unfinished bottles. This allows you to try several different wines and enjoy the remainder the next day. If you'd like to take the bottle home, let your waiter know.
